- By submitting a design, you promise that the artwork you submitted: is your original creation; has not been copied in whole or in part from any other work; does not say bad or false things about other people; and has never been previously published or submitted to any other competition.
- The decisions of the judges are final and binding. Mesa Public Library will attempt to notify the parents/guardians of winners using the information provided in the entry form by the end of business on September 30, 2024. If a winner's parent or guardian cannot be contacted or does not respond within 48 hours of the first contact attempt if a winner does not fulfill the eligibility requirements if a winner does not adhere to the Official Rules, or if the prize notification is returned as undeliverable, that winner will be disqualified, and contest organizers may select a new potential winner by the same criteria set forth above.
